Applications being accepted for Webinar Leads

- Offering two grants of \$1,000 each to Member Organizations to be the 'leads' for the webinars
 - Back to School and Off to College
- Member organization will be responsible for recruiting and speakers, finalizing the presentations and content.
- Webinar will be 'co-branded' by EAA and the member organization.
- EAA will support with the logistics for the webinar (Zoom Webinar) and Facebook Live (if available)

Everyone needs a SAP – Video Content

- Epilepsy Alliance America will create a video content for its website and social channels around the importance of Seizure Action Plans, Talking to your Family and Friends about Seizure Action Plans and Rescue Medications.
- Create a series of 6-8 short (less than 30 seconds) videos of people 18+ years of age talking about Seizure Action Plans, Rescue Medications. Videos will be debuted no earlier than September 2023 and no later than November 2023.

Grants for Member Organizations

- Approximately \$45,000 will be available in grants
 - Select Partner Members will receive a larger share of the grant 'pot'
 - Non Profit Members will be eligible for smaller grants
 - Anyone who's Dues are currently waived is not eligible for grants

Members can use the grants for...

- Print flyers for distribution to students with epilepsy
- Postage to disseminate flyers for students with epilepsy
- Provide funding for travel – particularly to rural areas – to provide programs for students with epilepsy
- Host “Camp Prep” webinars or meetings for constituents
- Provide “Camp Prep” information and/or materials for constituents
- Provide scholarship funds for campers
- Provide care packages for campers (example – cooling vests)
- Provide care packages for first-year college students
- Provide back to school ‘what is epilepsy’ sessions for students
